A Tale of Two US Towns.....

As climate change impacts larger sections of US coastal towns, the idea of climate-induced migration is not longer an abstract concept that is only impacting islands in the Pacific Ocean. A 2016 study suggests that a 6 ft (1.8 m) rise in sea levels by 2100, fuelled by a collapse of the polar ice caps, could lead to 13.1 million American along the coasts losing their homes to the rising tide. Even a more modest rise of 3 feet would leave 4 million homeless. (Quartz - A Tale of Two Towns)
